

Perspectives: *Hidden Secrets* film exposes Christian struggles with sin and doubt

A new movie hitting theaters for a one-day-only premier on April 30 promises to "tear off the blinders" and show people affected by sexual temptation and promiscuity, homosexuality, abortion, judgmental hypocrisy, suicidal feelings, failed hopes, doubt and despair -- and those are the Christians. Actor-producer David A.R. White says Pure Flix Entertainment's upcoming release, *Hidden Secrets*, is a story "about real people with real struggles."

The movie's plot centers around the sudden death of a "hometown hero" whose faith and friendship have deeply influenced the lives of those around him. As friends and family come together in the aftermath of the funeral, a tangled mesh of past hurts, mistakes, spiritual doubts, and unresolved relationships begins to unravel, and certain "hidden secrets" are forced into the light. Actors Tracey Melchior, John Schneider and others co-star with White in a film that he says "wrestles with tough issues believers face daily but are often hesitant to discuss". "We know that in churches ... we find people who have either had an abortion, struggled with homosexuality, or given in to sexual temptation," the Christian actor notes, "yet we would rather not talk about it." White says *Hidden Secrets* tries to blast through that reticence to show that "Christians are affected by these issues" and "that there is hope and redemption, no matter what the issue," and also tries "to approach these topics in a humorous way, because laughter helps in dealing with life when it gets tough."

Hidden Secrets premieres nationally on April 30 only, showing in 200 theaters in 26 markets across the U.S. More information is available at the film's official website, HiddenSecrets-theMovie.com, including promotional materials for churches and groups that want to get involved in the screening.
